Thanksgiving cactus or Christmas cactus are versatile, long-lived and familiar plants easily grown in homes and gardens. We see their cousins in spring and know them as Easter cacti.

In their native rainforests in Brazil, like certain types of orchids they grow as epiphytes, living on air, water and soil debris in trees and cracks in rocks. In Southern California they flower profusely in fall, winter or spring adding exotic flower forms and color. Join Master Gardeners to learn about the care and cultivation of these beautiful plants.
